



Affordable Connectivity Program Helping Households Connect

The Affordable Connectivity Program is an FCC program that helps connect families and households struggling to afford internet service.

The Affordable Connectivity Program provides:

- A \$30/month discount for broadband service.

The Affordable Connectivity Program is limited to one monthly internet service discount per household and is non-transferable.

Who is Eligible?

A household is eligible for the Affordable Connectivity Program if the household income is at or below 200% of the [Federal Poverty Guidelines](#), or if a member of the household meets at least *one* of the criteria below:

- Participates in certain assistance programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, Federal Public Housing Assistance, SSI, WIC, or [Lifeline](#); or
- Is eligible to participate in the National School Lunch Program or the School Breakfast Program, including through the USDA Community Eligibility Provision; or Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year.

Two-Steps to Enroll

1. Go to ACPBenefit.org to submit an application or print out a mail-in application; and
2. Contact [DE LightSpeed](#) at 662-477-1975 or info@delightspeed.coop to select a plan and have the discount applied to your bill after you receive ACP approval for the benefit.

Eligible households must **both apply for the program and contact [DE LightSpeed](#) to select a service plan.**
